That Management shall credit Employee Franklin Bamba for all benefits, which shall include any leave and contributions made to the Government of Guam Retirement Fund representing all the time from the date of termination on July 6, 2011 until the date of reinstatement commensurate with the terms of this settlement; and,
- 4. That Management shall pay Employee Franklin Bamba's reasonable attorney's fees in the amount of Two Thousand Two Hundred & 00/100 Dollars (\$2,200.00). Said attorney's fees shall be paid directly to the Law Office of Cunliffe & Cook.
