This matter came before the Board of Commissioners of the Civil Service Commission on September 16, 2014 for the presentation of an initial assessment report. Seven (7) Port Employees filed with the Civil Service Commission an appeal of the Port Authority of Guam's violation of Nepotism rules. After presentation from Personnel Management Analyst III Maria L.G. Cruz, the Board voted 6-0 to authorize the Commission staff to undertake further investigation. The staff of the Commission is therefore ordered to commence investigation of the issues raised by the Seven (7) Port Employees. 
