Funding for Department of Corrections (DOC) Electronic Locking

System

Pursuant to Section 1 of Public Law No. 33-01, the Bureau hereby request for your concurrence on the proposed transfer of \$1,700,000 from the General Fund appropriations allocated to the Public Safety Vacancy Pool Cost Account to the DOC to provide for the additional funding necessary to complete the Electronic Locking System project.

The Director of DOC in his memorandum to the Governor of Guam dated March 6, 2015 is requesting for the additional funding indicated as the current available funding of \$300,000 from the Department of Interior grant is insufficient based on a recent assessment conducted with interested vendors. The project is now estimated at a cost \$2,000,000. (See attachments.)

As you know, the DOC cannot proceed with the Request of Proposal (RFP) until the funds are made available and until such time the Bureau receives your concurrence on the proposed transfer.



SUBJECT: Funding for Electronic Locking System

Hafa Adai! Please find the attached cost analysis for the Electronic Locking System, as provided by the Department of Public Works and the University of Guam. Through the Department of Interior funding, \$300,000 was allocated for the repairs and upgrade for this project. After conducting a walkthrough with interested vendors, it was concluded that the project exceeds the \$300,000 budget that was originally allocated. The project is now estimated at a cost of \$2,000,000.

Please be advised as per the Attorney General's Office we will not be able to proceed with the Request for Proposal (RFP) until the funds are made available. Therefore, this is to respectfully request your assistance in allocating the additional funding of \$1,700.000 to the department to be able to proceed with the RFP.

This is to certify that Substitute Bill No. 22-33 (COR), "AN ACT TO ADD A NEW SECTION 5 TO CHAPTER XIV OF PUBLIC LAW 32-181, RELATIVE TO AUTHORIZING I MAGA'LAHEN GUÂHAN'S TRANSFER AUTHORITY FROM THE PUBLIC SAFETY VACANCY POOL COST ACCOUNT TO COMPLY WITH THE UNITED STATES DISTRICT COURT OF GUAM ORDER DATED JANUARY 16, 2015 IN CIVIL CASE NO. 91-00020; TO AUTHORIZING THE ATTORNEY GENERAL OF GUAM TO PROCURE EXPERTS TO ASSIST IN COMPLYING WITH THE SAME; TO AUTHORIZING THE GENERAL SERVICES AGENCY TO PROCURE DISCOUNTED MEDICINE ON BEHALF OF THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS; AND TO REQUIRING THE DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS TO REPORT TO THE SPEAKER OF I LIHESLATURAN GUÂHAN ON MATTERS RELATIVE TO CIVIL CASE NO. 91-00020," was on the 20th day of February, 2015, duly and regularly passed.

Section 1. A new Section 5 is hereby added to Chapter XIV of Public Law 3 2-181 to read:

"Section 5. Additional Authorization. Notwithstanding the department and agency appropriation allocations in Section 1 of this Chapter, I Maga'lahen Guåhan, subject to the requirements of this Section, may transfer General Fund appropriations allocated to the Public Safety Vacancy Pool Cost Account to the appropriate department and/or agency for the sole purpose of complying with the United States District Court of Guam Order dated January 16, 2015 in Civil Case No. 91-00020. Prior to the transfer of any appropriations in this Section, the Attorney General of Guam must review and concur in writing that such transfer is for the sole purpose of complying with the United States District Court of Guam Order dated January 16, 2015 in Civil Case No. 91-00020. No appropriation that is transferred in this Section shall be used for the expenditure of private legal counsel for the government of Guam. No appropriation that is transferred in this Section shall be used for the expenditure of any contract for a term exceeding one (1) year; or for any purpose that may result in the extension, modification, addition, or change order to any existing contracts with the government prior to the enactment of this Act. Nothing in this Section shall constitute an authorization for the government to enter into any long-term contractual arrangement for construction and/or professional services exceeding one (1) year, nor shall any appropriations authorized for transfer herein be for such purpose(s). The Director of the Bureau of Budget and Management Research shall provide a notice and amount of each transfer authorized by this Section, including a copy of the written concurrence by the Attorney General of Guam, to the Speaker of

1 I Liheslaturan Guåhan no later than five (5) days after such transfer is 2 authorized and/or made." 3 Carryover of FY 2014 Appropriations for the Office of the 4 Attorney General. Notwithstanding any provision of law, the unexpended balance 5 of appropriations from the General Fund to the Office of the Attorney General for its 6 operations in Fiscal Year 2014 shall not lapse and shall carry over into Fiscal Year 7 2015. Such funds shall only be expended up to Seven Hundred Thousand Dollars 8 (\$700,000) for the purposes described in Section 3 of this Act. 9 Section 3. Authority of the Attorney General to Procure Experts. 10 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Attorney General is authorized to 11 procure consultants and/or expert witnesses, on a sole source basis, as necessary, to 12 comply with the United States District Court of Guam Order dated January 16, 2015 13 in Civil Case No. 91-00020. No government funds except those appropriations 14 described in Section 2 of this Act may be expended for this purpose. 15 Section 4. General Services Agency Permitted to Procure Medicine. 16 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Services Agency is authorized to procure medication for the Department of Corrections directly from 17 18 distributors or manufacturers for the sole purpose of complying with the United States District Court of Guam Order dated January 16, 2015 in Civil Case No. 91-19 00020; and may procure on a sole source basis, as necessary, provided, that the total 20 21 cost savings must be more than twenty percent (20%) less than the cost paid by the 22 Guam Memorial Hospital Authority. To the maximum extent possible, procurement shall be achieved expeditiously and competitively, as provided in Title 5 GCA 23 24 Article 3. Sole source procurement *shall* be a method of last resort. 25 Section 5. Reporting Requirements. The Director of the Department of

Corrections shall provide a written report to the Speaker of I Liheslaturan Guåhan no

later than twenty (20) days after the end of each month on all matters agreed upon in

- 1 the United States District Court of Guam Status Report dated September 26, 2014 in
- 2 Civil Case No. 91-00020; and matters addressed in the United States District Court of
- 3 Guam Order dated January 16, 2015 in Civil Case No. 91-00020. The Director of the
- 4 Department of Corrections shall also provide to the Speaker of I Liheslaturan
- 5 Guåhan a copy of the weekly reports regarding clinical operations at the Department
- 6 that are provided to the Monitor of Civil Case No. 91-00020, no later than five (5)
- 7 days after such report is provided to said Monitor. I Liheslaturan Guåhan herein
- 8 recognizes that the reports required under this Section shall not be released if such
- 9 reports are under seal by the courts.
- 10 Section 6. Effective Date. This Act shall become effective upon enactment.
- 11 Section 7. Severability. If any provision of this Act or its application to any
- 12 person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity shall not affect other provisions
- or applications of this Act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or
- application and to this end the provisions of this Act are severable.
