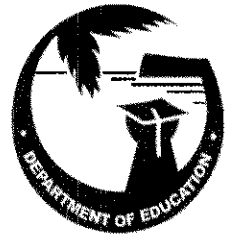

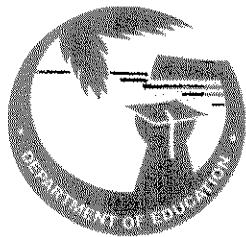

**WHEREAS**, Albert T. San Agustin served the students, parents, staff, and community of Guam for thirty-eight years (38) as a faithful servant in the field of education; and

**WHEREAS**, Albert T. San Agustin earned his Bachelor of Arts degree in Social Science and Education from the Territorial College of Guam in 1967; and

**WHEREAS**, Albert T. San Agustin embarked on his journey in the field of education as a Head Start teacher with the Territorial College of Guam in 1967 and continued to serve the students of Guam as a teacher from 1967-1970 and 1974-1975; and

**WHEREAS**, Albert T. San Agustin earned his Master's Degree in Secondary School Administration and Curriculum from the University of Guam in 1970; and

**WHEREAS**, Albert T. San Agustin served as a School Program Consultant with the Federal Programs Division from 1970-1971; and

**WHEREAS**, Albert T. San Agustin served in a leadership role as the Deputy Director of Education from 1972-1974; and

**WHEREAS**, Albert T. San Agustin served as Executive Assistant to Governor Ricardo Jerome Bordallo, from 1975-1976; and

**WHEREAS**, Albert T. San Agustin faithfully served as the Director of Education for the public school system from 1976-1977; and

**WHEREAS**, Albert T. San Agustin was elected to the Board of Education and served as a member and chairman between 1980-1982; and

**WHEREAS**, Albert T. San Agustin also served as a GED/Adult Basic Education Instructor, Upward Bound Counselor, Central Texas College Instructor, Guam Community College Instructor, University of Guam Instructor and Alumni Relations Coordinator, Graduate Assistant to Dale Carnegie Institute and the University of Minnesota, Planner for the American International University President and Educational Leadership Consultant to the Chuuk Department of Education; and

**WHEREAS**, Albert T. San Agustin was elected to the Guam Education Board and served as a member from 2013-2015 with the following members of the board, Mr. Peter Alexxis D. Ada; Ms. Lourdes M. Benavente; Mr. Kenneth P. Chargualaf; Mrs. Charlene D. Concepcion; Dr. Jose Q. Cruz; Mrs. Maria A. Gutierrez; and Ms. Lourdes B. San Nicolas; and


