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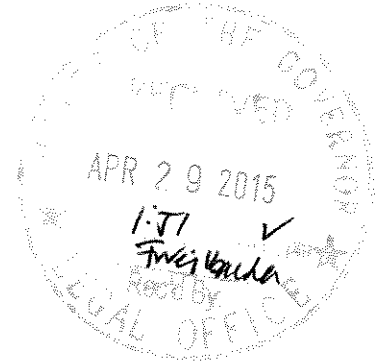

Subject: Request for Emergency Declaration to provide Security Services at three (3) locations for the Department Of Public Health and Social Services



Attached is a memorandum from the Director of the Department of Public Health and Social Services' for an emergency declaration to allow for the continued service of uniformed and unarmed security officers for up to three (3) months.

As noted in their memorandum dated April 23, 2015, the use of the uniformed and unarmed officers is necessary to protect the pharmacies, government vehicles and records that are located in all three facilities. The Department also believes that the service also services as a deterrent to anythreats of inappropriate entry into the facilities, potential acts of vandalism and theft.

The General Services Agency did announce a bid on January 29, 2015, however, upon a notice of an intent to award the bid, a protest occurred regarding the stated bid price. After the protest was denied, an appeal was lodged with the Office of Public Accountability, where it currently resides. A hearing to discuss motions and other administrative matter is scheduled for April 27, 2015.

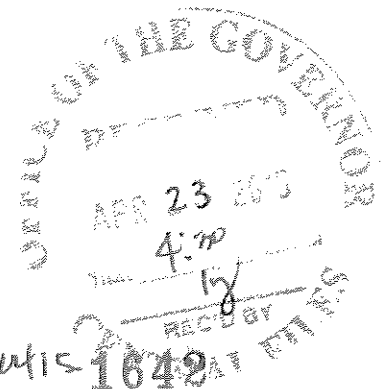
