#### BOARD OF TRUSTEES Official Resolution No. 15-54

"RELATIVE TO APPROVING TWO HUNDRED TWENTY-EIGHT (228) NEW FEES AND UPDATING EIGHT THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED SEVENTY-FOUR (8,274) PROFESSIONAL FEES"

WHEREAS, Public Law 26-66, places the rate making authority of the Guam Memorial Hospital Authority under the GMHA Board of Trustees; and

WHEREAS, the GMHA Board of Trustees has reviewed the Public Law 26-66; and

WHEREAS, a Public Hearing was held on March 30, 2015 and oral comments and written testimony have been solicited for the Two Hundred Twenty-Eight (228) new fees comprised of the following Hospital departments: Urgent Care, Nursing, Labor & Delivery, Central Supply Room, Radiology, Pharmacy, Respiratory, Operating Room, Laboratory, Special Services and Telemetry; and

WHEREAS, the Public Hearing was also held to update the Eight Thousand Two Hundred Seventy-Four (8,274) Professional Fees effective April 1, 2015; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees Finance & Audit Committee met on April 29, 2015, reviewed and recommended that the Board of Trustees approve the 228 new fee items and the 8,274 updated professional fees; and

WHEREAS, the GMHA Board of Trustees has reviewed the list of new fees and the updated professional fees and found the same to be in order; and

WHEREAS, the Hospital has realized One Million Four Hundred Eighteen Thousand Six Hundred Forty-Five Dollars and Cents 76/100 (\$1,418,645.76) in revenues since the inception of the 228 new fees; now therefore be it,

**RESOLVED**, that the GMHA Board of Trustees accepts and approves the recommendation of the Finance & Audit Committee and adopts the 228 new fee items and the 8,274 updated professional fees, and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Chairperson certifies and the Secretary attests to the adoption of this resolution.

#### MINUTES

In accordance with the Administrative Adjudication Law, a public hearing was held on Monday, March 30, 2015, at 10:00 a.m. in the GMHA Daniel L. Webb Conference Room, to solicit public opinion on the Hospital's 8,177 existing fees and 228 new rates, fees, and charges.

Note: Copies of the Public Hearing Agenda and the Listing of New Rates, Fees, and Charges were made available to all attendees.

#### I. <u>Introduction</u>

Ms. MaryAnn Palomo introduced herself as the Presiding Public Hearing Officer for this public hearing. Our public hearing recorder was Mrs. Candy Chan. Ms. Palomo began conducting the public hearing at 10:05 a.m.

#### II. Opening Remarks

On behalf of the GMHA Board of Trustees, the Interim Hospital Administrator/CEO, the Chief Financial Officer, and the GMHA employees, Ms. Palomo welcomed the public for attending the public hearing. She then commenced presenting the purpose of the public hearing today.

#### III. Purpose of the Public Hearing

As mandated by Public Law 29-02, Chapter V, Part IX, Section 2, §3131 enacted on May 18, 2007, all government departments and agencies shall conduct a public hearing, on an annual basis prior to April 1, on existing fee schedules and shall regularly adjust existing fees, pursuant to the Administrative Adjudication Act, or implement new fees for the purpose of cost recovery.

In accordance with the enactment of Public Law 26-66 in December 2001, which removed the rate-setting jurisdiction from the PUC and gave it to the GMHA Board of Trustees:

#### 10 GCA §80109 Hospital Rates

"(c) The Authority may establish interim fees for new, un-tariffed services, medication and supplies, without prior legislative approval and without compliance with the Administrative Adjudication Law; provided, that: (1) the interim fees are consistent with the Authority's Net Revenue Enhancement Engagement Pricing Model, as prepared by Deloitte & Touche, dated February 7, 1992, or such other protocol as may be approved by the Board of Trustees; and (2) a petition for permanent approval of the interim fees is filed by the Authority with I Liheslaturan Guahan within three (3) months of the Authority's establishment of the interim fee."

#### V. <u>Testimonies from the Public</u>

Ms. Palomo noted that no attendees from the public had signed up for testimony. She informed that the public could submit a written testimony to the Hospital Administrator/CEO within five (5) days after this public hearing. These testimonies would be incorporated into the submission package to the 33<sup>rd</sup> Guam Legislature, subsequent to the approval by the GMHA Board of Trustees.

# VI. Questions and Answers on the Proposed New Rates, Fees and Charges and Existing Fee Schedules

Ms. Palomo commenced soliciting from the public for any questions they might have concerning the 8,177 existing fees and the 228 new fee items presented at this public hearing today.

Ricky Martin of TakeCare Insurance inquired if the Hospital's fees were based on current Medicare rate. Mr. Patacsil responded that the Hospital is using the Deloitte & Touche pricing model based on the landed cost multiplied by mark up. Mr. Martin requested if the pricing model was available for review. Mr. Patacsil responded that it is available for review.

Jeffrey Larsen of Takecare inquired if there is an equivalent in terms of Medicare PFR or some other methodology adjustment that would be analogues to Deloitte's model or audit. Mr. Patacsil responded that Deloitte did not do a Medicare comparison but an analysis for the Hospital. He would conduct a research on the equivalent fees and provide a response.

Anthony Mendiola of StayWell inquired about the adjustment of professional fee, especially if Anesthesiology service would be affected. Mr. Patacsil responded that Anesthesiology service would not be affected.

Mr. Larsen also inquired if the professional fees were greater than 5%, or capped at 5%. Mr. Pataesil responded that the Hospital is using the 2015 Physicians' Fee Reference (PFR) at 50<sup>th</sup> percentile plus geographic multiplier, but would not include the additional 5%.

Ms. Palomo added that the 5% across the board increase is only on hospital/facility fees and would not affect the professional fees. Mr. Patacsil would provide his confirmation.

Frank Campillo of Selectcare requested the Hospital to notify the payers at least a quarter in advance for any proposed fees or fee increase before implementation. Mr. Mizusawa responded that the Hospital would present the request to the Board of Trustees to make the decision and would provide a response. He added that for next year, it is reasonable for the Hospital to disclose to the insurers any fee increase to the insurance 90 days in advance to ensure they have time to assure the fees are accurate. He would present to the Board of Trustees for fees disclosure approval for next year or any other fee increases.

Mr. Larsen reminded that the Hospital had the 90-day agreement with the insurers for the Urgent Care fees. With the new set of fees in place, he asked if the Hospital would bring the insurers back for discussion and if this set of new fees were higher than the originally agreed fees. Mr. Patacsil responded that the fees should be at Medicare rates +30%. He would verify and

confirm. Ms. Palomo added that she would discuss with the Chief Financial Officer as to scheduling the meeting with the insurers.

Mr. Larsen also inquired if the Urgent Care fees proposed 90 days ago and the new fees were set for the rest of the fiscal year. Dr. Lizama responded that these fees were subject to re-evaluation and would depend on the Hospital's decision how to move forward. He indicated that we would need to have a contract based on the agreement. He would discuss with the Hospital's Chief Financial Officer to develop the contract that would allow us to move forward as a participating urgent care provider. The Hospital would provide a response later.

Mr. Larsen expressed his statement that the Hospital's proposed new fees are keeping pace with market rates, especially for those new services that replace the old products. Dr. Lizama commented that he did not know about that statement.

Mr. Campillo inquired if the Telemetry Observation Room and Board rate at \$97.50 per hour was correct. Mr. Patacsil stated that it should have been a pro-rate of about \$31.00+ per hour, which he would be amending the rate as soon as possible.

Ms. Palomo reminded that the public would have five days to submit their written testimonies to the Hospital Administrator and that Mr. Patacsil would follow up on some of the questions and would provide a response to the insurers.

#### VII. Closing Remarks

In closing, Ms. Palomo thanked everyone for making the time in their busy schedules to attend this public hearing. We would notify in advance of any future public hearings regarding fees.

#### VIII. Adjournment

Ms. Palomo called the hearing to adjourn at 10:48 a.m.

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# Morrison, San Nicolas tangle anew over youth programs

A DAY after tangling over Department of Administration acting Director Anthony Blaz's confirmation, Sens. Tommy Morrison and Michael San Nicolas were at it again yesterday, this time clashing over Bill 3-33.

The measure seeks to authorize the procurement of sports equipment and supplies for the youth and community sports programs.

But during yesterday's session, Morrison said he was shocked that San Nicolas tied the compensation of mayors to the procurement of youth sports equipment and supplies.

"Despite objections from me and several of my colleagues. debate on Bill No. 3-33 (LS), as amended, was suspended and the measure was returned to the Committee on Finance and Taxation, General Government Operations and Youth Development," Morrison said in a statement.

He emphasized that Bill 3 was introduced at the request of Guam's mayors and vice mayors, as well as officials from the Guam Department of Education and Department of Parks and Recreation, to help equip school and commurecreational facilities nity with much-needed sports inventory.

During yesterday's debate on the measure, Morrison said he attempted to address concerns raised by his colleagues, including San Nicolas, which has oversight on Bill 3-33 (LS). However, Morrison said he couldn't support one of San Nicolas' amendments, specifically a provision that

funds Guam's mayors and vice mayors could spend to help sponsor sports teams, purchase sports uniforms and equipment, and other supplies that would strengthen community youth programs.

#### Mayors' letter

In response to the amendment by San Nicolas, Morrison said Guarn's mayors and vice mayors signed off a letter which was submitted to the legislature yesterday strongly opposing the amendment. He said Guam mayors and vice mayors stated that they have every intention of using the funds that would be appropriated through the bill to continue the refurbishment and repair of various community recreational facilities.

"Moreover, they stated during the public hearing held on the measure that they would appreciate the flexibility to use some of the funds provided by would limit the amount of P.L. 32-60 to procure sports equipment and supplies." Morrison said.

Morrison also quoted Angel Sablan, executive director of the Mayors' Council of Guam, as saying that approximately \$116,000 from different sources was used by mayors in the previous fiscal year to sponsor youth teams and uniforms and to pay for the management of leagues, which included the cost for umpire and referee Services

"Mr. Sablan further stated that while it would be great to have all of our community recreational in beautiful condition, it would be devastating to see these fields and courts empty because youth sports teams weren't able to afford uniforms and other basic sports equipment and supplies," Morrison said.

He added that suggestions made during yesterday's session by San Nicolas, the

legislature's chairman on youth development, that mayors should use their pay raise to buy sports equipment and supplies, "is absolutely disrespectful" and insulting.

"Mayors and vice-mayors, like several senators, the governor, and other community leaders, have and continue to spend their personal funds to help support various fundraising efforts involving youth sports activities, off-island medical treatment, and other needs. Our mayors and vice-mayors don't deserve to be lectured about the need to support our youth. This is something they do every day out of the kindness of their hearts," Morrison said.

He added: "It's extremely unfortunate that Senator San Nicolas' comments on Bill 3, and his subsequent support to return my bill to his committee, happened during the same

#### San Nicolas response

Responding to Morrison, San Nicolas yesterday said Bill 3-33 would have taken money originally set aside to fix sports facilities throughout the island and instead use the funds for clothing and various equipment and supplies.

"I don't know why Senator Morrison keeps trying to fight with me on pay raises, tax refunds, and now fixing our sports facilities. I am just trying to make sure that the money is there to fix the broken sports facilities and playgrounds in our villages, San Nicolas said.

"I would hope that we could all get along and continue the work of doing what is best for our people," he added.

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

## Pacific International buys Mariana Express

PACIFIC International Lines (PIL) recently completed its purchase of Mariana Express Lines. According to its website, Singapore-based Pacific International is the world's 16th largest container ship operator.

A Mariana Express Lines company circular sent to customers noted that effective March 10, Pacific International Lines and the Lucn Thai Group will be the new majority owners of Mariana Express Lines (MELL).

The acquisition could mean reduced shipping costs for its customers and the end consumer, the company said.

Thank you for the opportunity to submit written testimony on the Guam Memorial Hospital Authority's (GMHA's) "new fee items/services" presented this week at your March 30 hearing. I note that the hearing material indicates an eventual submission to the Guam Legislature. As you are well aware, I take a keen interest in the developments at the GMHA, particularly with respect to its finances, and I have done so for a number of years preceding my chairmanship of the Legislature's Committee on Appropriations.

For the purpose of this letter, rather than submit a commentary on the 228 individual new fees the hospital is now proposing, I would like to focus on the rationale of creating new fees in light of GMHA's continuing billing problems. In doing so, I would even describe billing as the GMHA's "Achilles' heel."

Only a couple of weeks ago, on March 13, 2015, it was reported in the media that GMHA sent multiple bills for the first three (3) months after its new billing system was implemented in October 2014. On two different occasions, patients were sent two separate bills (facility charges and professional charges). While the news report pointed to a mere inconvenience on patients having to deal with two bills for different services for one visit, it stated "For those patients who may have received duplicate bills (emphasis added), the hospital is willing to assist customers with their concerns and encouraged customers to call (GMH)." Further, I understand that any significant delays in billing may result in larger discounts to the insurance companies per the hospital's contractual agreements with them. To that end, does it seem prudent to assess new fees while the hospital has yet to fully resolve its issues with billing?

Dr. Lizama, billing has been and continues to be an issue. And, I have been critical of the hospital for a number of years on this subject. In January 2013, I indicated to your former Administrator my dismay that the hospital spent millions of dollars on

"upgrades" to GMH's revenue, financial, and clinical systems without procuring the actual hardware to support it.

If the hospital's audited financial statements are any indication, GMHA's ability to collect has gone from bad to worse, at least since January 2011. From FY 2008 to FY 2013, the provision for bad debts has practically doubled, going from \$36 million to \$71 million. In FY 2009 net patient revenues peaked at \$92 million, but in the most recent released audit, at the close of FY 2013, it was a mere \$69 million. It would seem to me that any aggressive effort to collect on bad debts would need a properly equipped and implemented billing system in place.

For the reasons above I question GMHA's rationale of pursuing additional fees and fee increases without first resolving its perennial billing issues.

Following are the clarifications to your concerns raised during the March 30, 2015 public hearing:

1. Deloitte and Pricing Model

The Deloitte and Pricing Model is a cost-based pricing methodology which combines the results of department net revenue determinations with cost allocation results. The model utilizes three mark-up rates: 5.343 for supplies; 2.756 for pharmacy; 6.04 for services/procedures. For supplies/pharmacy, charge rate is based on the landed cost multiplied by the mark-up. For procedures, charge rate is based on the labor multiplied by the mark-up. The model also utilizes a "capitation policy" to prevent overcharging. Supply capitation-\$500.00 Pharmacy capitation-\$200.00.

2. Deloitte and Touche rate vs. Medicare rate

GMH Medicare Cardiac rehab, op w/o ekg monitor (CPT 93797) \$58.14 \$103.29 Echocardiogram, 2d (CPT 93307) \$87.22 \$427.27 Rh typing, d (CPT 86901) \$9.32 \$12.12 NB hearing screening 1st step (CPT 92587) \$52.15 \$74.41 Dressing application (CPT9 97602) \$27.45 \$83.73 NM-Gastroesophageal reflux (CPT 78262) \$243.66 \$323.78 Chest physio, initial (CPT 94667) \$33.39 \$78.19

3. 5% across the board increase 5% across the board increase applied only to the hospital/facility charges, not for the Professional Fees. The Profee update was based from the 2015 Physicians Fee Reference

at 50th percentile multiplied by the geographic multiplier (Hawaii).

4. Urgent care doctor's fees As agreed upon, the rates are based from the 2015 Medicare rates plus 30%.
