US proposes rules for the era of drones

WASHINGTON (AP) - Drone on, the government says



people except those involved in the drone's operation would be prohibited.

We have tried to be flexible in writing these rules," said FAA Administrator Michael Huerta. "We want to maintain today's outstanding level of aviation safety without placing an undue regulatory burden on an emerging industry."

The agency is researching technology that he hopes will eventually enable small drones to fly safely beyond the sight of operators, Huerta said. He emphasized that introduction of commercial drones into the national airspace will be a staged process. The government is also looking ahead to how larger drones might be allowed to fly in airspace shared by manned aircraft, for example, he said.

One of the key safety concerns is that without a human on board the ability to "see and avoid" other aircraft is limited. Another concern is that the link between the operator and a remote control aircraft can be broken. causing the drone to fly away until it loses power or collides with something

SAN FRANCISCO (Repters) - Japanese carmaker Honda Motor Co Ltd. plans to slow production at some of its plants in North America due to a parts shortage caused by a partial shutdown of ports along the West Coast.

The company expects shortages at its operations in Ohio, Indiana and Ontario, Canada, starting Monday and for each plant to adjust its production between Feb. 16 and Feb 23, spokesman Mark Morrison told Reuters by email

Ports along the U.S. West Coast are near gridlock due to a lengthy labor dispute between dockworkers and the group representing shippers and terminal operators

With cargo delays rippling through the US economy, President Barack Obama on Saturday dispatched U.S. Labor Secretary Tom Perez to California to help broker an agreement between shapping companies and dock workers.

We do not have a sufficient supply of several critical parts to keep the production lines running smoothly and efficiently These parts include a small number of critical parts such as electronics, and some larger assemblies such as transmissions," Morrison said. Security company: Hackers steal up to \$1B from banks

NEW YORK (AP) - A hacking ring has stolen up to \$1 billion from banks around the world in what would be one of the biggest banking breaches known, a cybersecurity firm says in a report scheduled to be delivered Monday.

The backers have been active since at least the end of 2013 and infiltrated more than 100 banks in 30 countries, according to Russian security company Kaspersky Lab.

After gaining access to banks'

computers through phishing schemes and other methods, they lurk for months to learn the banks' systems, taking screen shots and even video of employees using their computers, the company says.

Once the hackers become familiar with the banks' onerstions, they use that knowledge to steal money without neising suspicions, programming ATMs to dispense money at specific times or setting up fake accounts and transferring


money into them, according to Kaspersky. The report is set to be presented Monday at a security conference in Cancun. Mexico. It was first reported by The New York Times.


The hackers seem to limit their theft to about \$10 million before moving on to another bank, part of the reason why the fraud was not detected earlier, Kaspersky principal security researcher Vicente Diaz said in a telephone interview with The Associated Press.

The attacks are unusual because they target the banks themselves rather than customers and their account information, Diaz said

The goal seems to be financial gain rather than espionage, he SHO

In this case they are not interested in information. They're only interested in the money, he said. "They're flexible and quite aggressive and use any tool they find useful for doing whatever they want to do.
