AN ACT TO *AMEND* SECTION 2(II)(AF) OF CHAPTER I AND SECTION 1 OF PART I, CHAPTER II OF PUBLIC LAW 32-181; TO ADD A NEW SECTION 17 TO PART I, CHAPTER II OF PUBLIC LAW 32-181; AND TO AMEND §22425(q) OF ARTICLE 4, CHAPTER 22, TITLE 5, **GUAM** CODE ANNOTATED. RELATIVE TO APPROPRIATING START-UP FUNDS FROM THE TERRITORIAL EDUCATIONAL FACILITIES FUND FOR THE GUAM DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION (GDOE) EARLY CHILDHOOD **EDUCATION** PROGRAM/PRE-KINDERGARTEN PROGRAM; AND TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL FUNDS TO THE GDOE FOR ITS OPERATIONS AS A RESULT OF THE ENACTMENT OF PUBLIC LAW 32-219.

1	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:
2	Section 1. Section 2(II)(AF) of Chapter I of Public Law 32-181 is hereby
3	amended to read as follows:
4	"AF. Territorial Educational Facilities Fund \$31,200,000"
5	Section 2. Section 1 of Part I, Chapter II of Public Law 32-181 is hereby
6	amended to read as follows:
7	"Section 1. Appropriation. Pursuant to §§ 52101 and 52102 of
8	Chapter 52, Division 2 of Title 11 GCA, the sum of Two Hundred Thirty
9	Three Million Five Hundred Nineteen Thousand Seven Hundred Sixty Two
10	Dollars (\$233,519,762) is appropriated to the Guam Department of
11	Education (GDOE) Operations Fund for Fiscal Year 2015. This sum is
12	composed of Two Hundred Million Twenty Five Thousand Two Hundred
13	Fifty Three Dollars (\$200,025,253) from the General Fund (including
14	advanced appropriations from P.L. 32-068), and Thirty Three Million Four
15	Hundred Ninety Four Thousand Five Hundred Nine Dollars (\$33,494,509)
16	from the Public Library Resources Fund, the Territorial Educational
17	Facilities Fund (including the continuing appropriation in P.L. 32-63, as
18	amended by P.L. 32-120), the Healthy Futures Fund, and the School
19	Lunch/Child Nutritional Meal Reimbursement Fund. This appropriation
20	shall be expended in accordance with the cash disbursement schedules
21	required by §52101(b) of Chapter 52, Title 11 GCA, and in accordance with
22	the object class allocations outlined below:

5	Section 3. A new Section 17 is hereby added to Part I, Chapter II of Public
6	Law 32-181 to read:
7	"Section 17. The sum of Two Million Eighty Five Thousand Ninety
8	Nine Dollars (\$2,085,099) is hereby appropriated from the Territorial
9	Educational Facilities Fund (including the continuing appropriation in §
10	22425(q)(8), Chapter 22, Title 5 GCA) to the Guam Department of
11	Education (GDOE).
12	(a) Early Childhood Education Program Start-up Funding.
13	The sum of Nine Hundred Eighty Two Thousand Five Hundred
14	Ninety Three Dollars (\$982,593) shall be allocated from the
15	Territorial Educational Facilities Fund (including the continuing
16	appropriation in § 22425(q)(8), Chapter 22, Title 5 GCA) in this
17	Section to the GDOE for the Early Childhood Program Fund (created
18	pursuant to § 22425(q)(7), Chapter 22, Title 5 GCA) for the sole
19	purpose of funding an Early Childhood Education Program and the
20	development and implementation of the Pre-Kindergarten Program in
21	four (4) public schools identified by the Department to pilot such a
22	program. This allocation shall not be subject to transfer by I
23	Maga'lahen Guåhan or GDOE. A breakdown of the appropriation in
24	this Section is as follows:

(b) The sum of One Million One Hundred Two Thousand
Five Hundred Six Dollars (\$1,102,506) shall be allocated from the
Territorial Educational Facilities in this Section to the GDOE for
additional funding for its operations as a result of the enactment of
Public Law 32-219.

(c) The Superintendent of the GDOE shall conduct a
formative and summative evaluation of the Early Childhood

- (c) The Superintendent of the GDOE shall conduct a formative and summative evaluation of the Early Childhood Education pilot program over a period of three (3) years. The evaluation results shall be submitted annually to the Legislature and shall be considered prior to an expansion or continuation of the program."
- **Section 4.** §22425(q) of Article 4, Chapter 22, Title 5, Guam Code Annotated, (not including §§ 22425(q)(1) through 22425(q)(12)) is hereby *amended* to read:
 - "(q) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, any additional real property tax revenues above the amount of Twenty Million Seven Hundred Fifty Five Thousand Seven Hundred Ten Dollars (\$20,755,710) (the average of the actual collections of real property taxes between Fiscal Years 2012 and 2014) is hereby continuously appropriated annually, *not to exceed* Eight Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$8,500,000), from the Territorial Educational Facilities Fund in the amounts and for the purposes set forth in this Subsection:"
- Section 5. Effective Date. This Act shall take effect upon its enactment.
- **Section 6. Severability.** If any provision of this Act or its application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity *shall not* affect other provisions or applications of this Act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application and to this end the provisions of this Act are severable.
