IV. OLD BUSINESS:

1. Hearing on the Merits (continuation):

Rodney F. Akima vs Port Authority of Guam; Case No. 14-AA14S

By a vote of 6-0 the Commissioners voted to ratify the report given by the CSC staff, but to Order the Port to reorganize the department so that the two brothers would not share a Supervisor Subordinate relationship.
