**STATUS:**

The following activities took place during the period of October 1, 2014 through June 30, 2015:

- 1<sup>st</sup> Quarter – No monies
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Quarter – No monies
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter – \$211,256.00 (as of June 30, 2015)
  - Initial loading of monies into account May 2015
  - October 2014 - May 2015: \$156,296.00

  - Vehicle Parts; Tires
  - Services and Repairs for fleet vehicles

**PROCUREMENT (if applicable):**

- 230 – Contractual – encumbered \$32,489.01 (16 Requisitions)
  - Costs associated for fleet vehicles that need repairs, to include but not limited to parts and labor;
- 240 – Supplies – encumbered \$49,264.29 (32 Requisitions)
  - Costs associated to purchase parts for fleet vehicles, to include but not limited to: tires, bulbs (marker/left beam), starter repair kits, hub assembly (front/rear), calipers (R RT/R LT), rotors (front/rear), rotor assembly kits, pad kits (front/rear), alternators, head lamp, filter oil/air, shaft assembly, seal, motor parts, shaft assembly, bearing assembly, radiator, head light, gasket, brakes, etc.
- 450 – Capital Outlay - \$63,377.00 (0 Requisitions)
  - Average costs for patrol vehicle \$45,000.00;
  - Vehicle Committee established to create specs for anticipated purchases of patrol fleet vehicles.
