

**AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FROM THE  
FISCAL YEAR 2014 HOTEL OCCUPANCY TAX (HOT)  
SURPLUS FUND TO THE GUAM VISITORS BUREAU.**

1        **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2        **Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.** *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds  
3 that there exists Three Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (**\$3,500,000**) in the  
4 Fiscal Year 2014 Hotel Occupancy Tax Surplus Fund available for appropriation.

5        **Section 2. Appropriation.** Notwithstanding any provision of law, the  
6 sum of Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (**\$200,000**) is hereby appropriated from  
7 the Fiscal Year 2014 Hotel Occupancy Tax Surplus Fund to the Guam Visitors

1 Bureau for the improvement, refurbishment, restoration, repair, and/or  
2 maintenance of one (1) park or attraction per village, including village murals.  
3 Notwithstanding the general provisions of § 30107.1 of Chapter 30, Title 11, Guam  
4 Code Annotated, this appropriation *shall* continue to be available until expended  
5 and is *not* subject to transfer or use for any other purpose.
