Enclosed is the Consolidated Revenue/Expenditure Report for the period ending August 31, 2015. There are several statutes requiring monthly reports of revenues in addition to a report requiring both revenue and expenditure comparisons. 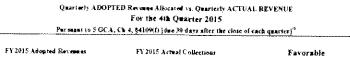

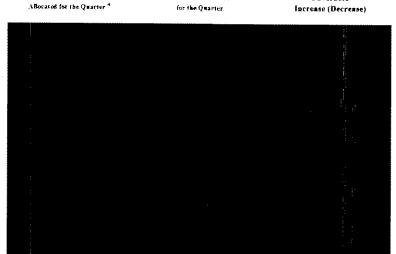
