**Project Title:** Saltonstall-Kennedy Competitive Research Program/GU-CNMI Fish Import-Export Database

**Details:** Funding under this grant will be used for monitoring the activity of fishing imports and exports throughout the Mariana Islands. A database system will be developed for monitoring and collecting data for analysis of fishing activities. In maintaining the responsibilities of the database personnel will be needed; two data clerks along with fringe benefits for retirement, medical, dental, medicare, and life insurance. Travel costs will go to a roundtrip airfare for three from Guam to CNMI for data collection and evaluation. Supplies will be needed for standard operation procedures to carry out the project. Contractual services are also included in the budget for a database developer.
