In accordance with 22 GCA §44104, the Guam Department of Labor conducted a public hearing on Thursday, November 19, 2015, to receive opinions and recommendations from businesses and the general public to determine which areas need additional professional and skilled technical trade workers which will be incorporated into the Guam Registered Apprenticeship Program Demand Occupations Listing. As a result of the public hearing there were twelve (12) occupations added to subject listing. The total of demand occupations on Guam is now at 304. 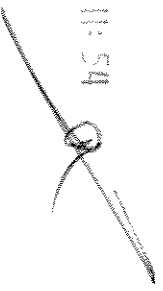

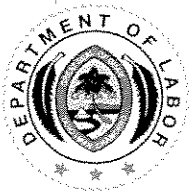

Types of Training:

- ◆ The **Time-Based** approach measures skill acquisition through the individual apprentice's completion of at least 2,000 hours of on the job learning as described in a work process schedule.
- ◆ The **Competency-Based** approach measures skill acquisition through the individual apprentice's successful demonstration of acquired skills and knowledge, as verified by the program sponsor. Programs utilizing this approach must still require apprentices to complete an on-the-job learning component of Registered Apprenticeship. The program standards must address how on-the-job learning will be integrated into the program, describe competencies, and identify an appropriate means of testing and evaluation for such competencies.
- ◆ The **Hybrid** approach measures the individual apprentice's skill acquisition through a combination of specified minimum number of hours of on-the-job learning and the successful demonstration of competency as describe in a work process schedule.
