MINUTES

1.0. CALL TO ORDER / ROLL CALL

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Michael Makio at 3:10 p.m., and roll call was conducted.

2.0 ELECTION OF OFFICERS

Joe Quinata reported the current fund is \$5.1 million with a total of \$1.1 million available for grants and projects.

The bid opening of three homes in the historic district of Inalahan is scheduled for December 11.

The Board discussed the Memorandum of Understanding on the Manuel Guerrero building and current legislation being routed to re-appropriate the unused balance for the repairs of the Umatac Bridge.

Chairman Makio requested Legal Counsel Terrence Brooks to review the law and the Legislature's authority to utilize funds released to the Trust.
