RELATIVE TO INARAJAN MUNICIPAL PLANNING COUNCIL OPPOSING THE PLANS OF THE GUAM ENVIROMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY TO DISPOSE OF ASBESTOS AND ASBESTOS TAINTED WASTE AT THE LAYON LANDFILL.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE INARAJAN MUNICIPAL PLANNING COUNCIL, MUNICIPALITY OF INARAJAN:

WHEREAS, It has come to the attention of the Inarajan Municipal Planning Council that the Guam Environmental Protection Agency has not properly addressed health risks and other community concerns associated with the Guam EPA's proposal to allow the disposal of asbestos and asbestos tainted trash at the Layon Landfill; and

WHEREAS, In accordance with Solid Waste Permit renewed on January 28, 2015 Part IV — Operations, IV.A.3. Solid Waste Excluded; paragraph two (2) states: No hazardous waste shall be accepted for treatment, storage or disposal of at the landfill. Any prohibited waste received and accepted for disposal at the facility will constitute a violation of this permit; and

WHEREAS, The EPA Administrator Eric Palacios, which contradicts his current position of permitting hazardous waste asbestos material to be disposed at the Layon Landfill; signed the Solid Waste Permit renewed on January 28, 2015 with an expiration date of January 2020 now therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Inarajan Mayor's Office has had numerous inputs from residents of Inarajan to oppose the disposal of hazardous asbestos material into the Layon Landfill and that the Inarajan Municipal Planning Council is earnestly seeking the support of our honorable servants of the 33rd Guam Legislature to oppose the disposal of hazardous asbestos material into the Layon Landfill; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Chairperson of the Inarajan Municipal Planning Council certify and the Secretary attest the adoption hereof and that copies of the same be therefore transmitted to the Speaker, 33rd Legislature; the Chairman, Committee on Municipal Affairs, Housing & Recreation, 33rd Guam Legislature; the Chairman, Committee on Youth, 33rd Guam Legislature; and to the Honorable Eddie B. Calvo, Governor of Guam.
