WHEREAS, Bernadita Camacho- Dungca, Ph.D. fondly known as "Benit" was
born on May 31, 1940 and the daughter of Ignacio Rivera Camacho and Maria Rosario
Camacho; and

WHEREAS, growing up in a large family, she was one of eleven siblings she later
married the late +Vicente Taitingfong Dungca a Korean War Veterans and Guam Police
Department retiree who passed away August 25, 2010 after being married for 51 years
and had one son- John Felix Camacho Dungca married to Emily S. Dungca and have two
grandsons- John Vincente and John Paul and resided in Sinajana for many years; and

10 WHEREAS, she came to the University of Guam in 1973 from the East West 11 Center where she assisted in making the Chamoru Reference Grammar Book and co-12 authored the Chamoru English Dictionary and the University of Hawaii where she 13 earned her BA in Linguistics and Anthropology; and

WHEREAS, she was hired on a returning resident contract to teach Chamoru and
 assist in the training of bilingual bicultural teachers for the Guam Department and of
 Education, the CNMI, and the Federated States of Micronesia; and

WHEREAS, from a Federal ESEA Grant she initiated the Bilingual Bicultural
Teacher Education Program and she with Mr. Robert A. Underwood graduated seven
students before the grant ran out of money; and

WHEREAS, she also initiated the regional communication program for the region,
Hawaii, American Samoa and the South Pacific region using SSB &VHS radios and old
satellites donated by the outgoing satellite companies; and

WHEREAS, the whole experience brought the initiation of the
 Telecommunication and Distance Education Office which she managed and operated
 bringing distance education to the University of Guam; and

WHEREAS, this brought her to all of the Micronesians Islands, the CNMI,
 American Samoa, Canada. Japan, Hawaii, Fiji and Washington, D.C. and unfortunately,

1 WHEREAS, Dr. Camacho-Dungca's research interest were in the areas if 2 Chamoru indigenous rights and responsibilities and the need to help perpetuate the 3 Chamoru language and culture programs; and

WHEREAS s, beside the many lives she touched and inspired as a lifelong
educator, she will be most remembered as the author of the *Inifresi* which was composed
in 1991 as a moving tribute to the Chamoru culture and her role in publishing the first
Chamorro dictionary; now, *therefore be it*
