

**AN ACT TO ESTABLISH THE SOUTHERN RIVER
EROSION COUNCIL; AND TO AMEND § 68601 OF
ARTICLE 6 OF CHAPTER 68, TITLE 21, GUAM CODE
ANNOTATED, TO MANDATE THE CREATION OF
MULTI-YEAR MASTER PLANS TO ADDRESS THE
EROSION ISSUES RELATED TO RIVERS IN
SOUTHERN GUAM.**

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.** *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds
3 that there is a serious problem regarding the erosion along the banks of the
4 *Talofof* and *Ugum* Rivers, the *Namo* River, the *Manenggon* River, and other

1 rivers in southern Guam. *I Liheslatura* further finds that a recent site visit to the
2 *Talofofu* and *Ugum* Rivers was organized by the legislative Committee on Rules,
3 Federal, Foreign & Micronesian Affairs, Human & Natural Resources, Election
4 Reform and Capitol District, and the Soil and Water Conservation District; and it
5 involved various stakeholders, including federal and local government agencies,
6 the private sector, and elected leaders. The site visit brought to the forefront this
7 concern of the erosion and the need for action to address this concern. *I*
8 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* further finds that the continuing erosion along these rivers is
9 having impacts far beyond the loss of acreage on both publicly and privately
10 owned lands. The continuing erosion also threatens important heritage sites and the
11 jobs produced by the agricultural and tourism-related activities along the rivers.
12 The ongoing erosion is also adversely affecting the water quality of both rivers and
13 increasingly making these rivers less navigable and causing destruction to near
14 shore benthic habitats. *I Liheslatura* further finds that at a series of roundtable
15 discussions with stakeholders conducted by the legislative Committee on Rules,
16 Federal, Foreign & Micronesian Affairs, Human & Natural Resources, Election
17 Reform and Capitol District earlier this year, there was a consensus that to mitigate
18 this erosion would require a sustained, multi-year effort centered on dealing with
19 the watershed issues of the *Bolanos* Conservation Area, the waters from which are
20 causing the erosion problems along both rivers. It was also the consensus of these
21 roundtable discussions that a similar erosion problem was occurring along the
22 *Namo* River and is threatening residences and infrastructure adjoining the *Namo*
23 River. *I Liheslatura* further finds that in order to commence the process of taking
24 substantial, long term action to mitigate the erosion along the *Talofofu* and *Ugum*
25 Rivers, the *Namo* River, the *Manenggon* River, and other rivers in southern Guam
26 with similar erosion concerns, the involvement of the public and private
27 stakeholders should be provided with a statutory basis in order to sustain a multi-

1 year community-wide effort. *I Liheslatura* further finds that specific master plans
2 should be mandated to address the erosion concerns related to specific rivers in
3 southern Guam.

4 **Section 2. Southern River Erosion Council.**

5 (a) There is hereby created the Southern River Erosion Council (Council)
6 with the mission of identifying and monitoring measures to mitigate the ongoing
7 erosion of the banks of the following rivers in southern Guam:

- 8 (1) the *Talofof* and *Ugum* Rivers;
- 9 (2) the *Namo* River, including *Namo* Falls;
- 10 (3) the *Manenggon* River; and
- 11 (4) any other rivers in southern Guam with serious erosion
12 concerns as identified by the Southern River Erosion Council.

13 (b) In the case of each of the aforementioned rivers, the Council *shall*
14 recommend a specific mitigation strategy for the ongoing erosion along these
15 rivers in order to address the attendant adverse impacts of public concerns,
16 including, but not limited to: economic activity, infrastructure, water quality, the
17 environment, navigable waterways, public and private landowners, and heritage
18 sites. The Council *shall* report its findings and recommendations to the Southern
19 Development Master Plan Task Force established by Article 6 of Chapter 68, Title
20 21, Guam Code Annotated.

21 **Section 3. Composition of the Southern River Erosion Council.** The

22 Council *shall* be made up of the following members, who *shall* elect the
23 Chairperson of the Council:

- 24 (a) the Guam Department of Agriculture;
- 25 (b) the University of Guam;
- 26 (c) the Bureau of Statistics and Plans;
- 27 (d) the Guam Waterworks Authority;

- 1 (e) the Guam Environmental Protection Agency;
2 (f) the Department of Public Works;
3 (g) Department of Land Management;
4 (h) the Southern Guam Soil and Water Conservation District;
5 (i) the U.S. Department of Agriculture;
6 (j) the Mayor of *Agat*;
7 (k) the Mayor of *Umatac*;
8 (l) the Mayor of *Inarajan*;
9 (m) the Mayor of *Santa Rita*;
10 (n) the Mayor of *Talofofo*;
11 (o) the Mayor of *Merizo*;
12 (p) the Mayor of *Yona*;
13 (q) representatives of the U.S. Department of Agriculture, the U.S.
14 Army Corps of Engineers, or any other relevant federal agency invited by
15 the Chairperson of the Council to participate in the work of the Southern
16 River Erosion Council; and
17 (r) three (3) representatives of private landowners along the
18 *Talofofo* River, the *Ugum* River, the *Namo* River, the *Manenggon* River, or
19 any other river in southern Guam experiencing serious erosion problems.

20 **Section 4. Comprehensive Master Plans to Address the Erosion**
21 **Problems of the *Talofofo* and *Ugum* Rivers, the *Namo* River, the *Manenggon***
22 **River, and Other Rivers in Southern Guam as Identified by the Southern**
23 **River Erosion Council.** § 68601 of Article 6 of Chapter 68, Title 21, Guam Code
24 Annotated, is *amended* to read:

25 **“§ 68601. Geographical Definition.**

26 The Task Force created by this law (hereinafter Task Force) is hereby
27 charged with the duty, as specified by this law, to develop a comprehensive

1 Master Plan (hereinafter Southern Master Plan or Master Plan) for the
2 following villages: *Agat, Santa Rita, Umatac, Merizo, Inarajan, Malojloj,*
3 *Talofoyo* and *Yona*, and such areas adjacent to or located in between said
4 villages, including, but not limited to, any offshore areas such as *Cocos*
5 Island and any body of water as to which the government of Guam has
6 jurisdiction to develop; and since some of the plans or projects to be
7 advanced by the Task Force may have incidental effect, residue application
8 or extension related to other geographical areas under the jurisdiction of the
9 government of Guam, the Task Force may, when necessary and proper,
10 extend the application of the Southern Master Plan to such affected areas.
11 The Task Force *shall* also develop and incorporate into the Southern Master
12 Plan, specific master plans for the mitigation of the erosion problems along
13 the *Talofoyo* and *Ugum* Rivers, the *Namo* River, the *Manenggon* River, and
14 other rivers in southern Guam, based on the recommendations of the
15 Southern River Erosion Council.”
