FIDUCIARY DUTY. I ask each Commissioner to recommit to his or her fiduciary duty to the beneficiaries of the Land Trust. Take time to investigate other less harmful ideas, to hear from other experts, to negotiate directly on behalf of beneficiaries with others agencies, and not let the needs or desires of other parties or even the government of Guam drive your decisions. You are trustees, with a primary duty of loyalty to the Trust. A fiduciary duty is the strictest duty of care recognized by the US legal system. The Director of Land Management can be of great help and service to you in your role as trustees but is not a trustee and not obligated to the beneficiaries of the trust like you are Neither is GEDA. The Director of Land Management represents the Governor and the government of Guam in its quest for land for other purposes, for industry for other purposes, and the coveted ability to dedicate Guam's resources elsewhere. The CLTC statute was clear from the start that the Governor and the Director of Land Management. who have potentially conflicting views for the use of land on Guam, were not to have any power in the CLTC.³

I have no doubt that we can do better with the trust if we listen more to the beneficiaries. to those who have waited since 1995 and the new generation that has yet to apply, to those who have already paid for surveying and infrastructure on their own, and listen less to those who would use Trust assets for special interest and mere profit.

As Commissioners, you have the distinct honor to protect the Trust assets and more importantly, to protect Chamorro Homelands and the connection of people to the land. I imagine it is difficult and sometimes feels impossible. Do not be afraid, be open, be resourceful and diligent, and be aggressive if necessary. Call on all the people around you for help if you need support. You hold the fate of future generations in your hands. Your decisions will impact whether Chamorros remain the majority of the homeless on Guam. how long our island can survive global warming, and if our resources will support our self-determination. You have my respect and support, but not for this proposal to declare 600 acres unnecessary for residential or agricultural lease.

^{5 21} GCA § 75106. Other Officers Not to Control Chamorro Homelands; Exception. The powers and duties of the Governor and the department with respect to lands of the territory shall not extend to lands having the status of Chamorro homelands except as specifically provided for in this Chapter.
