Hafa Adai Governor Calvo,

I would like to thank you for the honor and privilege of allowing me to serve as a Board Member and Chairman of the Guam Visitors Bureau. In the four short years since taking the helm, our team has accomplished a great deal. With your support, together we effectively handled the 2/12 Tumon incident during my first month. We created the strategic plan that will guide Guam tourism for the next decade, *Tourism 2020*, and for the first time, Guam has the entire industry and all international markets driving towards a common vision and single set of objectives.

We set new records for visitor arrivals, diversified markets, added direct flights from Russia and China, improved Tumon and eradicated graffiti there, developed a Visitor Safety Officer program, and nearly doubled the TAF from just over \$20MM to \$40MM.

Administratively, the Board updated its Bylaws for the first time in 20 years, established SMART goals by committee, reorganised committee structures, and instituted proper corporate governance and compliance at the board level. Having proudly accomplished these tasks as a team, and with GVB management in a solid position to continue its great success under the outstanding leadership of Nathan Denight, I feel it is an appropriate time for me to step away and to focus on my core businesses.

Therefore, I ask that you please accept this letter of resignation as a Board Member and Chairman of the Guam Visitors Bureau effective Dec 31, 2016. I remain humbled by your loyal support and appreciative of your exemplary leadership on behalf of our island.
