

## AN ACT TO *ADD* A NEW § 19.80 TO CHAPTER 19, AND A NEW § 30.10 (a)(3) TO CHAPTER 30, BOTH OF TITLE 9, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO THE DEFINITION AND INCLUSION OF STRANGULATION IN GUAM'S ASSAULT AND FAMILY VIOLENCE STATUTES.

### **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

- 2 Section 1. A new § 19.80 is *added* to Chapter 19, Title 9, Guam Code
- 3 Annotated, to read:
- 4
- "§ 19.80. Strangulation; Defined & Punished.

(a) A person is guilty of strangulation if he knowingly or 2 intentionally, against the will of another, impedes the normal breathing or circulation of the blood of another by applying pressure to the throat or neck 4 or by blocking the nose or mouth of another.

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5 (b) Strangulation is a felony of the third degree; provided, that any person convicted of strangulation shall not be eligible for work release or 6 educational programs outside the confines of prison." 7

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8 Section 2. A new § 30.10 (a)(3) is added to Chapter 30, Title 9, Guam Code 9 Annotated, to read:

Knowingly or intentionally, against the will of another, 10 "(3) 11 impeding the normal breathing or circulation of the blood of a family 12 or household member by applying pressure to the throat or neck or by blocking the nose or mouth of a family or household member." 13

14 Section 3. This Act shall become effective upon Effective Date. 15 enactment.
