



AN ACT TO AMEND § 77135(c) OF ARTICLE 1, CHAPTER 77, TITLE 10, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO PROVIDING DISCRETION TO THE CHIEF OF THE GUAM POLICE DEPARTMENT (GPD) IN THE EXPENDITURE PRIORITIZATION OF THE POLICE **PATROL** VEHICLE AND **EQUIPMENT** REVOLVING **FUND** FOR THE **PURPOSES OF** ACQUIRING, REPAIRING, AND MAINTAINING VEHICLES AND REQUISITE ASSOCIATED EQUIPMENT FOR THE GPD.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- Section 1. § 77135(c) of Article 1, Chapter 77, Title 10, Guam Code
- 3 Annotated, is hereby *amended* to read:

"(c) Authorized Expenditure and Continuing Appropriation. All monies in the Fund are hereby appropriated, and *shall* be deemed appropriated on a continuing basis and *shall not* lapse, and *shall not* be subject to appropriation constraints in order to be expended for the purposes of acquiring, repairing, and maintaining vehicles and requisite associated equipment for the Guam Police Department. All monies in the Fund *shall* be expended at the discretion of the Chief of Police for the purposes of acquiring, repairing, and maintaining vehicles and requisite associated equipment for the Guam Police Department, or subsidizing the utilization of privately-owned vehicles for police service, patrol duty, and other law enforcement related functions, as provided pursuant to Chapter 56 of Title 10, Guam Code Annotated. The Fund *shall not* be used to purchase non-patrol vehicles for administrative utilization purposes."

**Section 2. Severability.** If any provision of this law or its application to any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity *shall not* affect other provisions or applications of this law that can be given effect without the invalid provisions or application, and to this end the provisions of this law are severable.
