AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 43250, ARTICLE
VII, CHAPTER 2 OF TITLE XXXIX, GOVERN-
MENT CODE OF GUAM, RELATIVE TO THE
EXPIRATION DATE OF INSURANCE LICENSES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 43250, Article VII, Chapter 2, Title
3 XXXIX, Government Code of Guam, is hereby amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 43250. License. It shall be unlawful for
5 any person to do or perform any act in Guam as an insurance
6 broker, general agent, subagent, or solicitor, or hold
7 himself out as such, for any kind of insurance without
8 holding a license then in force issued by the Commissioner.
9 Licenses and the renewals thereof shall be for a term
10 expiring the 1st day of July occurring after issuance. The
11 fee for each type of license and the renewal thereof shall
12 be ten dollars (\$10.00)."

13 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
