AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 6610.4 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM RELATING TO PER DIEM ALLOWANCE FOR THE SECRETARY OF GUAM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 6610.4 of the Government Code of

Guam is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 6610.4. Per Diem allowance. Any employee, and his dependents, including a spouse as authorized by item (c) of Section 6610.4, while traveling on official business and away from the designated post of duty of such employee, shall be allowed, in lieu of their actual expenses or subsistence, a per diem allowance in an amount prescribed according to regulations, but not to exceed \$20.00, except that the Governor, the Secretary, the Judges of the Island Court, and members of the Legislature shall be allowed \$35.00, and the directors and executive heads of the various departments and agencies of the Government of Guam, and such other officials as the Governor shall authorize shall be , allowed \$25.00. Guam's Washington Representative shall also be allowed a per diem allowance of \$35.00 while traveling on official business and away from Washington, D. C. except when he is in Guam." Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
