AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 6610.4 OF THE
GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM RELATING TO
PER DIEM ALLOWANCE FOR THE SECRETARY
OF GUAM.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 6610.4 of the Government Code of
3 Guam is hereby amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 6610.4. Per Diem allowance. Any
5 employee, and his dependents, including a spouse
6 as authorized by item (c) of Section 6610.4,
7 while traveling on official business and away
8 from the designated post of duty of such employee,
9 shall be allowed, in lieu of their actual expenses
10 or subsistence, a per diem allowance in an amount
11 prescribed according to regulations, but not to
12 exceed \$20.00, except that the Governor, the Secretary,
13 the Judges of the Island Court, and members of the
14 Legislature shall be allowed \$35.00, and the directors
15 and executive heads of the various departments and
16 agencies of the Government of Guam, and such other
17 officials as the Governor shall authorize shall be
18 , allowed \$25.00. Guam's Washington Representative
19 shall also be allowed a per diem allowance of \$35.00
20 while traveling on official business and away from
21 Washington, D. C. except when he is in Guam."

22 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
