Committee on Rules, by request of the Governor in accordance with Section 6(b) of the Organic Act of Guam.

AN ACT TO ADD A NEW SECTION 42019 TO CHAPTER I. TITLE XXXVIII, GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM, AND TO AMEND SECTION 42015 OF SAID CHAPTER RELATIVE TO THE GUAM MUSEUM.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. A new Section 42019 is hereby added to
3 Chapter I, Title XXXVIII, Government Code of Guam, to read
4 as follows:

5 "Section 42019. Guam Museum. The Guam Museum
6 shall be under the general cognizance of the Board which
7 shall have the authority, power and responsibility for
8 the administration and operation of the Guam Museum. The
9 Librarian shall be the executive officer for the Guam
10 Museum. The Guam Museum shall be the official depository
11 and custodian of historical artifacts in Guam."

12 Section 2. Section 42015 of the Government Code of Guam is
13 hereby amended to read as follows:

14 "Section 42015. Gifts. The Board shall have
15 authority to accept on behalf of, and in the name of, the
16 government of Guam, from any government or agency thereof,
17 or any person, advisory services, grants-in-aid, and gifts
18 and donations of money and other property for the benefit
19 of the Library, or the Guam Museum; provided that any
20 grant-in-aid, gift, donation or other form of assistance
21 involving an obligation on the part of the Library or the
22 Guam Museum or the government of Guam shall require the
23 approval of the Governor."

24 Section 3. This Act is an urgency measure.
