AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 4110.3 OF CHAPTER II, TITLE V, COVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM, RELATIVE TO NIGHT DIFFERENTIAL PAY FOR DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 4110.3 of Chapter 2, Title V, Government Code of Guam, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 4110.3. Night Differential Pay. All employees of the Department of Public Safety and the Department of Corrections, except the Directors, shall be entitled to night differential pay, calculated at the rate of their regular wage plus ten per cent (10%), for all periods worked between the hours of 6:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m."

Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
