AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 90 OF THE CODE
OF CIVIL PROCEDURE OF THE TERRITORY OF
GUAM TO REQUIRE LEGISLATIVE CONFIRMATION
OF INITIAL APPOINTMENTS TO THE ISLAND
COURT OF GUAM, AND TO REPEAL SECTION 93
OF THE CODE OF CIVIL PROCEDURE ESTABLISH-
ING THE NONPARTISAN JUDICIAL COMMISSION.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 90 of the Code of Civil Procedure of
3 Guam is hereby amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 90. Appointments to fill vacancies. Whenever
5 a vacancy shall occur in the office of judge of the Island
6 Court, or of the Police Court, the Governor, with the advice
7 and consent of the Legislature, shall fill such vacancy by
8 appointing a person possessing the qualifications for such
9 office."

10 Section 2. Section 93 of the Code of Civil Procedure of Guam
11 is hereby repealed.

12 Section 3. This Act is an urgency measure.
