AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 8901 OF THE COVERNMENT CODE OF GUAL TO REQUIRE MEDICAL CLEARANCES FROM APPLICANTS FOR REGISTRATION OF FIREARMS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PROPIE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 8901 of the Government Code of Guam is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 8901. Registration. No person shall own, or possess, or use any firearm of any description, whether usable or unusable, unless it shall have been registered with the Department of Public Safety and a certificate of registration obtained therefor. The application for registration and certificate of registration shall be on such forms as may be designated by the Director of Public Safety and shall include a description of the class of firearm, together with the name of the maker and the factory number, if known or ascertainable, the source from which possession was obtained, and a full description of the owner of the firearm. No firearm shall be registered to any person under the age of 18 years, or who has been convicted of any felony, or who is not a citizen of the United States.

The registration of any firearm under this chapter shall include the following items:

- (a) The name, age, place and date of birth and current address of the applicant.
- (b) The present occupation and employer of the applicant and the applicant's occupation and employer for the last five (5) years.

- (c) A sot of fingerprints of the applicant.
- (d) Such facts as will completely identify the firearm to be registered.

In addition, the Director may require, when the facts disclosed by the application warrant it, a medical clearance for the applicant from a physician licensed to practice medicine in Guan which clearance shall certify that the applicant is not suffering from epilepsy or other nervous disorder; and, in the opinion of the physician, is capable of using a firearm in a safe and careful manner and so as not to hazard others."

Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
