1 (c) A set of fingerprints of the applicant.

2 (d) Such facts as will completely identify the
3 firearm to be registered.

4 In addition, the Director may require, when the facts
5 disclosed by the application warrant it, "a medical clearance
6 for the applicant from a physician licensed to practice
7 medicine in Guam which clearance shall certify that the
8 applicant is not suffering from epilepsy or other nervous
9 disorder; and, in the opinion of the physician, is capable of
10 using a firearm in a safe and careful manner and so as not to
11 hazard others."

12 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
