AN ACT TO ADD SECTION 11001.7 TO THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAN TO REQUIRE THAT IN THE CONSTRUCTION OF ALL PUBLIC BUILDINGS, PROVISION BE MADE FOR THE PHYSICALLY HANDICAPPED.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 11001.7 is hereby added to the Government Code of Guam to read as follows:

"Section 11001.7. Provision for Physically Mandicapped. All buildings hereafter constructed by or for the
government of Guam intended for the use of the general
public shall be designed and constructed in such manner
as to permit the physically handicapped who are confined
to wheel chairs or otherwise of limited mobility ready
access to such buildings and to all parts thereof open to
the general public. All public buildings now in use by
the general public shall be modified, insofar as is
possible and practicable, to permit ready access by the
physically handicapped, and in leasing buildings for
public use, priority shall be given to those structures
where access to public areas by the physically handicapped
is provided."

Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
