AN ACT TO ADD SECTION 11001.7 TO THE
GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO REQUIRE
THAT IN THE CONSTRUCTION OF ALL PUBLIC
BUILDINGS, PROVISION BE MADE FOR THE
PHYSICALLY HANDICAPPED.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 11001.7 is hereby added to the Govern-
3 ment Code of Guam to read as follows:

4 "Section 11001.7. Provision for Physically Handi-
5 capped. All buildings hereafter constructed by or for the
6 government of Guam intended for the use of the general
7 public shall be designed and constructed in such manner
8 as to permit the physically handicapped who are confined
9 to wheel chairs or otherwise of limited mobility ready
10 access to such buildings and to all parts thereof open to
11 the general public. All public buildings now in use by
12 the general public shall be modified, insofar as is
13 possible and practicable, to permit ready access by the
14 physically handicapped, and in leasing buildings for
15 public use, priority shall be given to those structures
16 where access to public areas by the physically handicapped
17 is provided."

18 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
