AN ACT TO ADD SECTION 5008 TO THE  
GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO REQUIRE  
REPORTS TO ACCOMPANY LEGISLATION  
PROPOSED BY THE GOVERNOR.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 5008 is hereby added to the Govern-  
3 ment Code of Guam to read as follows:

4 "Section 5008. Report to accompany proposed  
5 legislation. Whenever the Governor transmits to the  
6 Legislature proposed legislation pursuant to Section 6(b)  
7 of the Organic Act of Guam, such proposed legislation  
8 shall be accompanied by a written report thereon con-  
9 taining the following items:

- 10 (a) A narrative statement and the reasons why  
11 said legislation is necessary.  
12 (b) What changes, if any, such proposed legislation  
13 will make in existing law, whether statutory  
14 or otherwise, if enacted.  
15 (c) A section by section analysis of the proposed  
16 legislation."

17 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
