Introduced by R. C. Sgambelluri

AN ACT TO ADD SECTION 124 TO THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO ADOPT AS THE OFFICIAL TREE OF GUAM THE LOCAL TREE KNOWN AS THE IFIT (INTSIA BIJUGA).

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 124 is hereby added to the Government Code of Guam to read as follows:

"Section 124. Guam Tree. There shall be and is hereby adopted an official territorial tree of Guam, which shall be the local tree known as the 'ifit' (Intsia bijuga)."

Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
