AN ACT MAKING DEFICIENCY APPROPRIATIONS
FOR THE OPERATION OF THE EXECUTIVE AND
LEGISLATIVE BRANCHES OF THE GOVERNMENT OF
GUAM FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30,
1968, AND FOR THE OPERATION OF THE LEGIS-
LATIVE BRANCH AND THE OFFICE OF WASHINGTON
REPRESENTATIVE FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR ENDING
DECEMBER 31, 1967, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

DIGEST ON BILL NO. 217(1-S)

The amounts requested totals \$424,971 broken down by Department to offset expenditures over and above those appropriated for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1968. In the accountant's report, the firm of Peat, Marwick, Mitchell, and Company pointed out that while these expenditures were not authorized, they were forced to reduce the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund by this amount.

The Legislature views with the gravest concern the continued over-expenditures of appropriations.
