AN ACT TO AMEND SECTIONS 26114 AND 26115 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM CHANGING THE HOURS OF OPERATION OF COCKPITS AND CLARIFYING THE ADMISSION FEES THERETO. 1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM: Section 1. Section 26114 of the Government Code of Guam 2 : is hereby amended to read as follows: 3 "Section 26114. Same: Hours. The hours of operation 1 of cockpits shall be as follows: 5 (a) Sundays, legal and/or church holidays, 6 10:00 a.m. to 12:00 midnight. 7 (b) On other authorized days, 10:00 a.m. to 8 12:00 midnight." 9 Section 2. Section 26115 of the Government Code of Guam 10 is hereby amended to read as follows: 11 "Section 26115. Same: admission fees. The 12 13 admission fee to a cockpit shall be as follows: (a) Each person entering the arena with a 14 15. fighting cock, one dollar (\$1.00). 16 (b) Each person entering the arena without a fighting cock, two dollars (\$2.00). 17 18 (c) The fees set forth in paragraphs (a) and 19 (b) of this Section shall not be deemed to include any excise tax on admissions levied by the government 20 21 of Guam, and the operator of a licensed cockpit shall charge and collect the excise taxes in addition to 22 23 the fees set out in said paragraphs." 24 Section 3. This Act is an urgency measure.
