AN ACT TO AMEND SUBSECTION (a) OF SECTION
2 OF PUBLIC LAW 9-192, NINTH GUAM LEGISLATURE
TO AUTHORIZE NON-PROFIT CORPORATIONS AND
ASSOCIATIONS TO PURCHASE GOVERNMENT LAND
AT DEDEDO AT LESS THAN THE FAIR MARKET
VALUE FOR LOW-COST HOUSING.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Subsection (a) of Section 2 of Public Law
3 9-192, Ninth Guam Legislature, is hereby amended to read as
4 follows:

5 " (a) In the manner hereinafter set out, the Governor
6 is authorized to enter into a contract or contracts with
7 any person, partnership or corporation, including any
8 non-profit corporation or association qualified to deve-
9 lop, own, and operate residential housing programs pursuant
10 to Section 221(d) (3) of the Housing Act, as amended, for the
11 construction and erection of residential houses for sale
12 or for rent in the case of housing programs authorized
13 under Section 221(d) (3) of the Housing Act, as amended,
14 to the people of Guam on those parcels of government-owned
15 land in the municipality of Dededo described as Parcels 1,
16 3, 4, and 5, as shown on Land Management Drawing No.
17 E-4-68S650, dated January 26, 1968."

18 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
