

AN ACT AMENDING SECTION 2 OF PUBLIC LAW
7-110, SEVENTH GUAM LEGISLATURE, TO GIVE
THOSE TEMPORARY EMPLOYEES MADE PERMANENT
BY THE PASSAGE OF SAID ACT RETIREMENT
CREDIT FOR THEIR PREVIOUS TEMPORARY
EMPLOYMENT.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 2 of Public Law 7-110, Seventh Guam
3 Legislature, is hereby amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 2. The employment status of those temporary
5 employees of the Public Utility Agency of Guam, and of the
6 Department of Public Works, the latter commonly referred
7 to as the 'Construction Battalion', shall be converted as
8 of the effective date of this Act from 'temporary' to
9 'permanent', subject to the following conditions:

10 (a) Initial appointment shall be probationary,
11 in accord with the Personnel Rules and Regulations;

12 (b) Such employees shall retain their current
13 class titles, subject to classification study, follow-
14 ing which compensation shall be adjusted to the first
15 step of the pay range of the position determined by
16 such study;

17 (c) For purposes of calculating leave and
18 retirement benefits, such employees shall be credited
19 with their temporary service prior to July 1, 1964,
20 except that to obtain such retirement credit, such
21 employees must pay into the fund by July 1, 1970 the
22 amount of contributions they would have made to the
23 fund had they been permanent employees at the time of
24 their temporary service."

25 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
