AN ACT AMENDING SECTION 2 OF PUBLIC LAW 7-110, SEVENTH GUAM LEGISLATURE, TO GIVE THOSE TEMPORARY EMPLOYEES MADE PERMANENT BY THE PASSAGE OF SAID ACT RETIREMENT CREDIT FOR THEIR PREVIOUS TEMPORARY EMPLOYMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM: Section 1. Section 2 of Public Law 7-110, Seventh Guam Legislature, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 2. The employment status of those temporary employees of the Public Utility Agency of Guam, and of the Department of Public Works, the latter commonly referred to as the 'Construction Battalion', shall be converted as of the effective date of this Act from 'temporary' to 'permanent', subject to the following conditions:

(a) Initial appointment shall be probationary,in accord with the Personnel Rules and Regulations;

(b) Such employees shall retain their current class titles, subject to classification study, following which compensation shall be adjusted to the first step of the pay range of the position determined by such study;

(c) For purposes of calculating leave and retirement benefits, such employees shall be credited with their temporary service prior to July 1, 1964, except that to obtain such retirement credit, such employees must pay into the fund by July 1, 1970 the amount of contributions they would have made to the fund had they been permanent employees at the time of their temporary service."

Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
