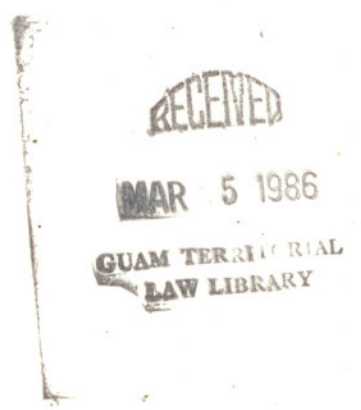

AN ACT TO REPEAL PUBLIC LAW 9-17,
NINTH GUAM LEGISLATURE, WHICH PRO-
HIBITED ISSUANCE OF FURTHER QUALIFY-
ING CERTIFICATES TO WATCH COMPANIES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Public Law 9-17, Ninth Guam Legislature,
3 (Section 53568.1, Government Code of Guam) is hereby repealed,
4 except that no more than four additional Qualifying Certificates
5 shall be issued to corporations manufacturing watches in Guam,
6 nor shall such a certificate be issued to a corporation which
7 did not produce and export into the customs area of the United
8 States during the calendar year 1968, watches under the watch
9 quota given the territory of Guam.

10 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
