AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE  
CONSTRUCTION OF A HIGHWAY EXTENSION AND  
TWO BRIDGES, FOR A HEALTH AND SOCIAL  
SERVICE CENTER, FOR DENTAL FACILITIES AT  
THE UNIVERSITY OF GUAM, FOR AN ADDITION  
TO THE UNIVERSITY HEALTH SCIENCE BUILDING,  
AND FOR THE CONSTRUCTION AND COMPLETION OF  
ADDITIONAL CLASSROOMS, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from any available  
3 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund, begin-  
4 ning July 1, 1969, the sum of Two Hundred Thousand Dollars  
5 (\$200,000) to supplement the appropriation made by Section 1 of  
6 Public Law 9-122, Ninth Guam Legislature, for the construction  
7 of the East Saylor Street Extension and the Togcha and Agat-  
8 Santa Rita bridges.

9 Section 2. There are hereby appropriated from any  
10 available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General  
11 Fund, beginning July 1, 1969, the following sums for the  
12 construction of the capital improvements set opposite thereto:

19 Section 3. The appropriations made by Section 1, Sub-  
20 section V-A, Public Law 9-122, Ninth Guam Legislature and by  
21 Section 1(c), Public Law 7-136, Seventh Guam Legislature are  
22 hereby repealed.

1           Section 4. The appropriations made by Section 1 and  
2 of this Act shall be available for all expenses incident to  
3 the purposes for which appropriated. Each appropriation made  
4 therein shall continue in full force and effect until expended  
5 for the project for which appropriated or until the project is  
6 completed.

7           Section 5. This Act is an urgency measure.
