AN ACT TO ADD SUBPARAGRAPH (d) TO SECTION 13210 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO REQUIRE THE USE OF APPROPRIATE CHAMORRO OR SPANISH WORDS IN THE TERRITORIAL STREET NAMING PLAN.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:
Section 1. Subparagraph (d) is hereby added to Section
13210 of the Government Code of Guam to read as follows:

"(d) In determining highway and street names, the plan shall include as far as practical Chamorro or Spanish words for the terms street, drive, avenue, alley, and similar words, utilizing in lieu thereof Chamorro words such as 'chalan' or Spanish words such as 'camino'."
