AN ACT TO ADD SECTION 125 TO THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO DECLARE THE TOTOT (PTILINOPUS) TO BE THE TERRITORIAL BIRD.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 125 is hereby added to the Government Code of Guam to read as follows:

"Section 125. Guam Bird. The local bird known as the 'Totot' (Ptilinopus) is hereby declared to be the official territorial bird."
