AN ACT TO ADD SECTION 125 TO THE
GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO DECLARE
THE TOTOT (PTILINOPUS) TO BE THE
TERRITORIAL BIRD.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 125 is hereby added to the Government
3 Code of Guam to read as follows:

4 "Section 125. Guam Bird. The local bird known
5 as the 'Totot' (Ptilinopus) is hereby declared to
6 be the official territorial bird."
