AN ACT TO ADD CHAPTER 6 TO TITLE II OF
THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO AUTHORIZE
THE LEGISLATURE TO JOIN THE NATIONAL
LEGISLATIVE CONFERENCE AND THE STATE
LEGISLATIVE LEADERS CONFERENCE.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Chapter 6 is hereby added to Title II of the
3 Government Code of Guam to read as follows:

4 "Chapter 6

5 National Legislative Conference and Legislative Leaders
6 Conference.

7 Section 1500. Membership in National Legislative
8 Conference. The Legislature is authorized to join, as a
9 participating member, the National Legislative Conference,
10 or its successor. Members of the Legislature may serve as
11 officers of such conference, which is an organization
12 composed of legislative staff members and legislators from
13 the legislative bodies of American States and territories,
14 the Legislature finding that its membership therein would
15 be of public benefit; provided, however, that in sending
16 delegations from the Legislature to the annual meeting
17 of said conference the members of the Legislature and
18 staff members who attend any meeting shall be determined
19 by legislative resolution.

20 Section 1501. Membership in Legislative Leaders
21 Conference. The Legislature is authorized to join, as
22 a participating member, the Conference of State Legis-
23 lative Leaders, or its successor. Members of the
24 Legislature may serve as officers of said conference,
25 which is an organization composed of the leaders of the
26 legislative bodies of the States and territories of the

United States, the Legislature finding that its participation therein would be of public benefit; provided, however, that in sending delegations from the Legislature to the annual meeting of said conference, the members of the Legislature who attend any meeting shall be determined by legislative resolution."
