Section 2. Statement of Legislative Intent. In appropriating funds for the operation of the Executive Branch for only two (2) months, as set out in Section 1 of this Act, it is the intent of the Legislature to provide the new administration now taking office in the Executive Branch an opportunity, during said two-months' period, to review the budget requests made by the outgoing administration and presented to the Legislature in January of 1969 so that the new administration can revise any request not in consonance with its program, and so that it will not be committed to carry out programs funded through June of 1970 which it had no part

in the planning. However, in order to preserve the status quo pending the review by the new administration of its budgetary requirements and its submission thereof to the Legislature, no new positions shall be created nor new executive programs initiated by the new administration during the two-month period provided for in this Act, the period being designed to permit a review by the new administration of current programs of the government and an opportunity to prepare its own plans and programs for submission to the Legislature for funding.
