

Introduced by F. T. Ramirez

AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR SUMMER
YOUTH EMPLOYMENT UNDER THE DIRECTION OF
THE GOVERNOR'S COMMITTEE ON CHILDREN AND
YOUTH AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from any avail-
3 able funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund
4 the sum of Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000.00) to the
5 Governor's Committee on Children and Youth for the purpose
6 of establishing a summer employment program whereby students
7 of the various public and private schools in Guam who are at
8 least sixteen (16) years of age are employed during the
9 vacation period between school years, to be paid at the rate
10 of seventy-five (75¢) cents per hour. Students employed under
11 this program shall not be eligible for retirement, sick leave
12 and annual leave benefits, and except as may be specifically
13 provided therein, the Personnel Rules and Regulations shall
14 not apply to such employment, but the Workmen's Compensation
15 Act shall apply.

16 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
