AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR SUMMER YOUTH EMPLOYMENT UNDER THE DIRECTION OF THE GOVERNOR'S COMMITTEE ON CHILDREN AND YOUTH AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000.00) to the Governor's Committee on Children and Youth for the purpose of establishing a summer employment program whereby students of the various public and private schools in Guam who are at least sixteen (16) years of age are employed during the vacation period between school years, to be paid at the rate of seventy-five (75¢) cents per hour. Students employed under this program shall not be eligible for retirement, sick leave and annual leave benefits, and except as may be specifically provided therein, the Personnel Rules and Regulations shall not shall apply.

Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
