

AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR
PRELIMINARY STUDIES OF PROVIDING NEEDED
OFFICE SPACE FOR THE THREE BRANCHES OF
THE GOVERNMENT OF GUAM.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from any
3 available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General
4 Fund the sum of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000) to the
5 Department of Public Works to undertake initial studies,
6 including the preparation of plans, drawings and specifications,
7 to provide additional needed office space and to renovate the
8 existing office space, of the executive, judicial, and
9 legislative branches of the government of Guam.

10 Section 2. Section 3, I-D of Public Law 9-167, Ninth
11 Guam Legislature is hereby repealed.

12 Section 3. This Act is an urgency measure.
