

AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR
THE OFFICE OF GUAM'S WASHINGTON
REPRESENTATIVE.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from any
3 available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General
4 Fund the sum of Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000) to the
5 Office of Guam's Washington Representative for the operations
6 of said office for the calendar year 1970.

7 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
